SUBJECT: Dress Code for the Magellan Inn Dining Facility and Skyline Flight Kitchen

1. The following dress code is for patrons of the Magellan Inn Dining Facility and Skyline Flight Kitchen. The purpose of this dress code is to maintain an appropriate, tasteful, and healthy atmosphere for all patrons:

a. All AF personnel will adhere to guidelines set forth in AFI 36-2903. Other military services personnel will adhere to guidelines in their applicable uniform/dress directives.

b. Civilian attire will reflect good taste and compare favorably with attire worn in similar off-base establishments.

c. Prohibited civilian attire or clothing items:

(1) Clothing specifically designed as undergarments (or gives the appearance of).

(2) Sleeveless shirts, muscle shirts, tank tops, "fishnet" shirts, tube tops or see-through shirts. Note: These items may be worn over top of authorized clothing.

(3) Clothing that is torn, tattered, frayed, or excessively soiled/dirty.

(4) Clothing that is saturated with perspiration from physical exercise/activity.

(5) Clothing that bears discriminatory, obscene, drug-promoting, or sexually suggestive designs, slogans, or patches.

(6) Hats, style caps or wave caps, and any other head garments.

2. Enforcement of this dress code is delegated to the senior on-duty facility manager, to include refusal of entrance and service.
