

SIRENA BEACH RESERVATION POLICY (Jan 2010)

The following rules must be adhered to by all users of Sirena Beach to ensure safety, sanitation, and to preserve the grounds and facilities.

Swimming is not permitted by order of the 36th Wing Commander

1. Absolutely no motor vehicles are allowed on the beach _____
2. Pole fishing is permitted 50 feet outside the swimming area. Permits are required in order to fish.
3. Scuba Diving is strictly prohibited.
4. No glass containers, pets or open fires.
5. The person(s) requesting the facility is responsible for any property damage and conduct of their guests.
6. Throw your trash in the large dumpster. Do not put trash in the trash can without a trash bag. A \$25.00 cleaning fee will be assessed if the entire facility is not clean; this includes the refrigerator.
7. Be aware of jellyfish, stonefish, and other dangerous sea life.
8. It is recommended that you lock the gate after your guests arrive. This is to prevent any unauthorized guests from entering Sirena Beach.
9. There is an emergency telephone located in the pavilion. Dial 911 for emergencies. The person(s) requesting the facility are responsible for informing their guests on the location of this telephone, water hazards, etc. x_____
10. All unit functions serving alcohol must submit an approval letter to the FSS/CC, IAW 34-119.
11. Active duty and retired military may make reservations 90 days in advance. All others at 60 days in advance.
12. Reservations are limited to 5 days and must be made in person with a 50% deposit. Cancellations must be made within 72 hours of reservation date to receive a refund. Full payment is required prior to using the facility.
13. The combination to the gate can be obtained no earlier than the day before the reservation. Check-in time is no earlier than 1200 hours. Check out time is no later than 1100 hours on the last day of your reservation.
